RATE FOR GAS SERVICE
GOVERNMENTAL HOUSING PROJECT SERVICE

No. 1 of 2 Sheets

TO WHOM AVAILABLE

The following rate is available to the United States of America, the State of Indiana, any municipal corporation, and any agency or agencies owned by any one of them, and any "Housing Authority" under the "Housing Authorities Act" of Indiana, upon written application in any case where the gas purchased hereunder is to be used in one federal, state or municipal low cost housing or slum clearance project in ZONE A (See Index).

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

This rate applies only to gas having a heating value of approximately 1,000 British thermal units (Btu) per cubic foot. Gas service as supplied under this schedule will be rendered through one meter only. The Company will extend its mains to a convenient point or points, to be selected by the Company, on the boundary line of the premises owned by the Customer. The Customer will provide at his expense all distribution lines, service, meters and other equipment beyond the point of metering by the Company.

CONTRACT FOR SERVICE

As a condition precedent to the Company supplying service under this schedule, the Customer shall enter into a written contract with the Company for a suitable initial contract period. In case the rates in effect under this schedule at the time of making any such contract are thereafter raised by authority of the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission, the Customer under such contract shall have the right to discontinue service at any time within sixty (60) days from the date the rate increase becomes effective, upon giving the Company at least ten (10) days' written notice of his election so to do.

RATE

Customer Charge

\$2.50 per dwelling unit including the charge for 2 therms per dwelling unit per month.

Commodity Charge

45.18 cents per therm for the next 5 therms per month per dwelling unit.
43.20 cents per therm for the next 10 therms per month per dwelling unit.
41.65 cents per therm for the next 75,000 therms per month.
35.34 cents per therm for all additional therms per month.

The dwelling unit count shall be the total number of single family apartments or individual family living quarters constructed in the project.

MONTHLY MINIMUM PAYMENT

The monthly Minimum Payment under this schedule shall be the Customer Charge plus the Rate Adjustment.

CORRECTION OF METERED QUANTITIES FOR BILLING

For the purpose of billing under this schedule, a therm shall be one hundred cubic feet of gas at a temperature of 60°F., at an absolute pressure of 14.65 pounds per square inch, having an average total heating value equivalent to 100,000 British thermal units (Btu). Metered quantities of gas, corrected for temperature and pressure conditions, shall be adjusted for Btu content by multiplying by the average heating value per cubic foot of gas, as determined for the latest monthly period available, and dividing by 1,000.

DEFERRED PAYMENT

All bills under this schedule shall be rendered and due monthly. If not paid within seventeen (17) days after the bill is mailed, there shall be added to bills of \$3.00 or less, 10% of the amount of the bill; and to bills in excess of \$3.00 there shall be added 10% of the first \$3.00 plus 3% of the amount of the bill in excess of \$3.00.

RATE ADJUSTMENT

This rate is subject to the Gas Cost Adjustment stated in Appendix A - Sheet No. 22.
