**CLEVELAND ROAD AT FIR ROAD TO BE TEMPORARILY CLOSED IN GRANGER
TOMORROW AND FRIDAY**

Granger, Ind. – Crews from Northern Indiana Public Service Company will be working to relocate an eight inch gas line along Cleveland Road in Granger, Ind., for an upcoming intersection improvement project.

Work is set to begin on Thursday, April 28 and, weather permitting, is expected to be completed on Friday, April 29.

During the relocation work, Cleveland Road at Fir Road, will be closed to traffic. Closure to begin at 9 a.m. ET and closed till dusk each day, and detour routes will be posted.

Westbound traffic will be directed north on Fir to S.R. 23, then west to the intersection of Cleveland Road and S.R. 23.

Eastbound traffic will be informed of the closure in advance and experience the closure at the intersection of S. R. 23 and Cleveland Roads. Vehicles will be directed to continue east on S.R. 23 until reaching Fir Road at which point they can turn south on Fir to reach Cleveland Road.
