This short-term project will lead to long-term benefits for you:

- Enhanced safety features
- Reliability of service for years to come
- Less future maintenance work in your neighborhood

WHAT WE'RE DOING:

Upgrading approximately 5 miles of electric distribution lines and 145 utility poles.

WHEN WE WILL BE WORKING: Work is expected to begin February 2019 and end November 2019, weather permitting.

Work will occur Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. - 5 p.m. On occasion, we may need to work evenings and weekends to honor customer appointments and deadlines. Schedules are weather dependent.

OUR TEAM IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD:

You will see us working with our contractor, Robert Henry Corporation. All of our employees and contractors can be identified by marked vehicles and also carry photo ID.

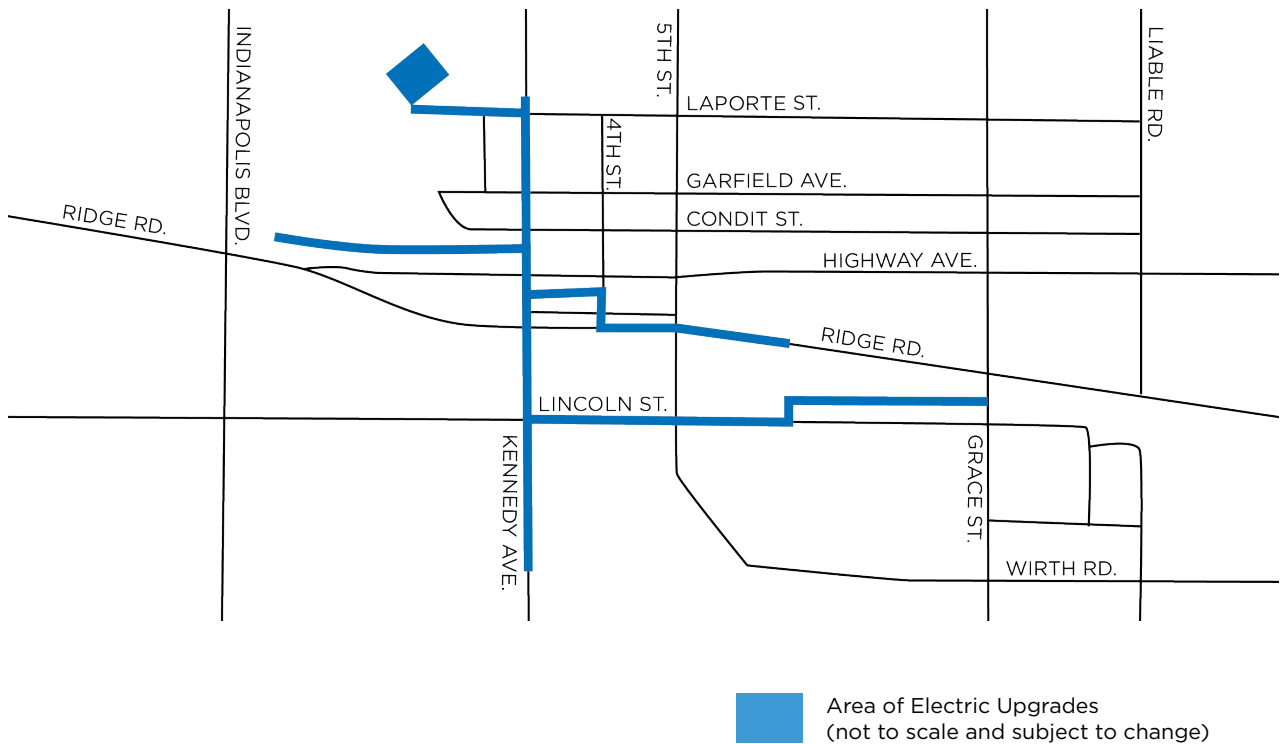
What to expect*:

- 1. Prep work.** To make sure no other underground utilities are damaged by this work, we will call 811 to have the public utilities marked with flags, stakes and temporary paint. *Please DO NOT remove these markings.*
- 2. Assess project path.** Obstructions in utility easements, such as fences and landscapes, may need to be removed.
- 3. Access to your property.** If we need access to your yard and/or if there are any issues within the path of construction, we will reach out to you directly.
- 4. Minimal service interruptions are expected to occur.** We will notify you ahead of time if a planned outage is needed.
- 5. Clean up.** After the project is complete, we will put back fences, lay black dirt and reseed. Please remember to water the new seed so it grows.

*If the project is complete during the winter months clean up may not happen until next spring.

- Temporary road and lane closures are expected. Signs will be posted ahead of time and detours will be in place.
