As part of an effort to upgrade the electric system across our service area, NIPSCO and contracted crews will be upgrading overhead electric transmission and distribution lines and wooden poles within the Kingsbury Industrial Park. This project will enhance reliability and safety for area businesses.

Project Facts

- Replace and upgrade approximately 15 miles of electric transmission and distribution lines and 395 wooden poles.
- Minimal service interruptions are expected to occur. NIPSCO will notify customers if a planned outage is needed.
- Work is expected to occur between Monday and Friday during normal business hours.

Project Timeline

- Expected Start of Replacement Work: April 2018
- Tentative Completion: December 2018

Additional Details

- Obstructions in utility easements, such as fences and landscapes, may need to be removed as part of the project. NIPSCO will work directly with property owners to alleviate any issues within the path of the project that may represent a problem for construction.
- At the completion of the project, site restoration will be completed using black dirt and seed.
- Temporary road and lane closures are expected. Signs will be posted ahead of time and detours will be in place.
- For your safety, please be aware and mindful of crews during construction.
