SPECIFICATION:

1. CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

- 1.1 Alternating current; 60 cycle, single phase, at a voltage of approximately 115/230 volts, three-wire.
- 1.2 Any residential electrical requirements of the customer will be served through the Farm Service Meter.

2. INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE:

- 2.1 All wiring and equipment of the premises of, and owned by the Customer, for utilization or service, shall be installed and maintained at the expense of the Customer in a manner to conform with the rules and requirements, of any recognized legal inspection service in effect in the community, and to a standard satisfactory to the Company.

3. ENTRANCE:

- 3.1 No entrance conduit, service, switch or wiring shall be smaller than 60 ampere, three wire, 115/230 volts, and the interior house wire shall be divided into two or more circuits and shall be so arranged as to place approximately one-half of the load on each side of the 115/230 volt service.

4. SINGLE PHASE MOTORS:

- 4.1 Single phase motors will be served under the residential class of service provided no motor is connected with individual rating in excess of 10 H.P.
- 4.2 Any one or more motors with individual motor rating in excess of 10 H.P. will be classified as power service. Lighting service may be supplied through the power service in accordance with the provisions of the applicable rate schedule.



5. OVERHEAD SERVICE CONNECTION:

5.1 The Company will supply an overhead service connection of not more than 135 feet in length from the most suitable pole of its distribution line to the pole, building, or terminal connection provided by the Customer. Where the distance to be spanned from the Company's pole to the Customer's service outlet exceeds 135 feet, the installation of the added length shall be handled as follows: Either the Customer may install the extra poles, brackets, wires and other equipment according to the Company's specifications or he may request the Company to do it. In either case, the cost of the extra installation will be born by the Customer.

6. OWNERSHIP, LINE EXTENSION:

6.1 The Company shall not be obliged to deliver to any line extension financed in part by the Customers until every Customer participating in said financing shall have agreed in writing, that the ownership of such line extension shall be vested in the Company.
