Residents and Businesses along Lake Shafer and Freeman Encouraged to Sign Up for Lake Level and Flow Alerts

Merrillville, Ind. — In an effort to improve notifications to the public regarding conditions along the Tippecanoe River, White County Emergency Management is providing alert options via phone and email to stay informed of any potential low-flow or flooding event that may arise.

White County Emergency Management has partnered with Everbridge, a free emergency alert system, to provide information regarding the Tippecanoe River and lake levels. You do not need to be a resident of White County to enroll in the alerts.

“It’s important for residents and businesses along the lake to get the information they need to stay safe,” said Roberta Yerk, director of White County Emergency Management. “We encourage anyone who would like timely and accurate information on lake level and river conditions to sign up.”

Everbridge provides critical information and emergency updates to the public within White County on a range of topics, including lake levels.
