WHY CALL 811?



- **It's the first step in any project.** When you call **811**, your local utilities will mark their underground lines so you can dig safely.
- **It's fast.** It only takes a couple minutes. Visit **811NOW.COM** or call **811 two business days** before you dig.
- **It's free.** The call and service cost nothing and can save you from expensive fines and repairs.
- **It's for everyone.** Whether you are a DIY person or professional contractor or landscaper, you always need to call **811**.
- **It's the law.** You'll help prevent gas and utility damages to keep us all safe. State law requires you to hand dig or use non-mechanized equipment within 24 inches of any flags or markings.

WHAT DO THE FLAGS AND PAINT MARKS MEAN?

The flags and paint marks identify where underground utilities are located.

Yellow flags or marks show where natural gas lines are located and red flags or marks show electric lines.

Do not remove or allow anyone to play or tamper with the flags or they will need to be remarked before digging begins.
