Throughout September, Northern Indiana Public Service Company LLC (NIPSCO) and Indiana-based NiSource employees rolled up their sleeves to support local nonprofits as part of the company's 15th annual Charity of Choice campaign, an employee-led tradition focused on service in the communities where employees live and work.

Cold Weather Energy Saving Tips

- Set water heater to 120 degrees Fahrenheit: Water heaters are one of the biggest energy users in the home. Check the temperature and take quick showers to use less hot water.
- Let the sun in: Use the sun's energy to help heat your home. Open blinds and drapes to let the sunshine directly into a room. Remember to close them when the sun goes down to insulate heat in.
- **Set ceiling fans clockwise:** Keep warm air circulating by running ceiling fans clockwise to draw air up.
