Northern Indiana Public Service Company LLC (NIPSCO), in collaboration with the NiSource Charitable Foundation, is proud to announce the 2025 recipients of our Public Safety Education and Training Action Grant. This year, 23 organizations across Northern Indiana have been selected to receive funding to advance local safety initiatives.

Since 2018, the grant program has supported 132 projects focused on youth and community safety education, as well as training for first responders, police and fire departments. Grants ranging from \$500 to \$5,000 have funded programs such as CPR/AED instruction, carbon monoxide awareness and lithium-ion battery response training.

Information about the annual grant opportunity was shared across NIPSCO's 32-county service area. Recipients were chosen by a committee based on a defined set of criteria.

We thank all applicants and congratulate this year's recipients for their continued efforts to make Indiana a safer place to live and work.
