WEATHER NORMALIZATION ADJUSTMENT RIDER

TO WHOM AVAILABLE

This Rider shall be applicable to the Rate Schedules identified in Appendix A.

ADJUSTMENT OF CHARGES FOR SALES RECONCILIATION ADJUSTMENT

Energy Charges in the Rate Schedules included in this Tariff are subject to adjustment each quarter to reflect the recovery of the difference between the monthly Authorized Test Year Weather Normalized Revenue (as approved by the IURC applicable to 8-month Period) as adjusted for actual number of customers and actual Weather Normalized Revenue. The adjustment shall be reflected as a charge or a credit effective for the bills rendered for the billing months of October through May (8 months). Such credits/charges shall be increased or decreased to the nearest 0.001 mill (\$.000001) per Therm in accordance with the following:

$$\text{WNA Factor} = R / S$$

Where:

- “WNA” is the rate adjustment for each Rate Schedule.
“R” equals the 8-month adjustment based upon the reconciliation of monthly Adjusted Authorized Test Year Weather Normalized Revenue to the actual monthly Weather Normalized Revenue amounts.
“S” is the 8-month Therm sales forecast for each Rate Schedule.

The WNA as computed above shall be further modified to allow the recovery of revenue based tax charges occasioned by the WNA revenues and later reconciled with actual sales and revenues.

WNA FACTORS

The WNA Factors are set forth in Appendix H.
