

UPGRADES COMING TO YOUR AREA

Work will soon be underway to upgrade the transmission towers and lines in your area.

TRANSMISSION UPGRADE East Chicago

This upgrade project is tied to increasing the energy capacity in East Chicago and ensuring future reliability of the system to better serve our customers.

WHAT WE'RE DOING:

- Retiring 7 existing electric transmission lattice towers and upgrading to steel monopole towers, between the existing Roxana Substation and Praxair Substation (see map).
- Upgrading approximately 2 miles of electric transmission lines.
- New energy conductor that provides for greater capacity.

WHEN WILL WE BE WORKING:

This project is expected to begin construction in mid-November 2019 and last until June 2020.

Crews will be working Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. We may need to work extended weekends and evenings to honor project deadlines.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Please be prepared for some digging and disruption as we replace and upgrade these transmission towers and electrical transmission lines. Construction will take place in the utility easement located under the current electrical transmission towers in your area.

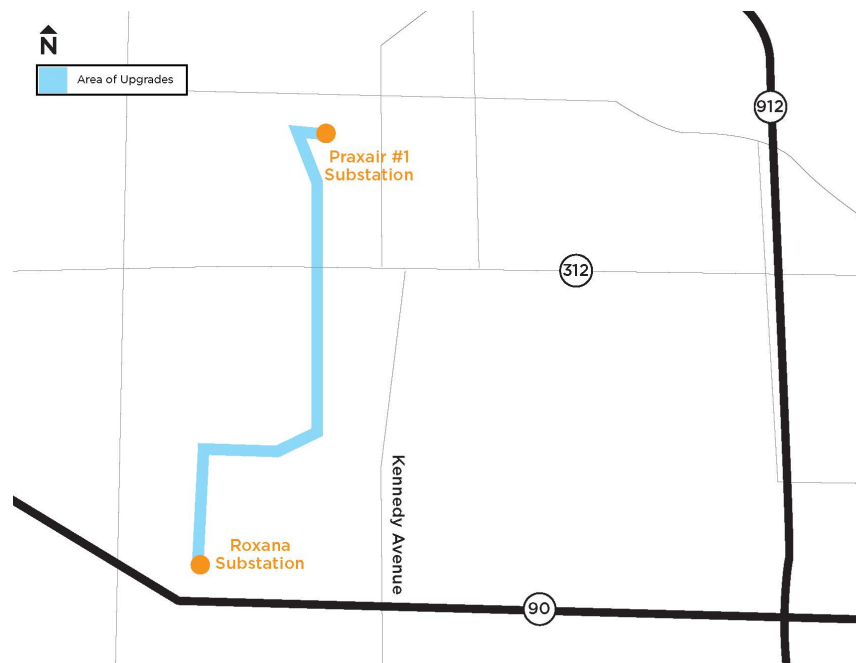
- **Path of Construction:** Obstructions in utility easements, such as fences and landscapes, may need to be removed. We will work with you directly, if there are any issues within the path of the project.
- **Service Interruptions:** There are no anticipated service interruptions with this project.
- **Clean Up/Restoration:** We will restore any area that was disrupted as a result of our work. Restoration will take place after the project is complete in the summer/fall months of 2020.

OUR TEAM IN YOUR AREA:

WORK ZONE SAFETY TIPS:

- Temporary road/lane closures are expected with this project, crews will post notification signs ahead of time and detour routes will be in place.
