We are upgrading underground electric wire and transformers in your neighborhood.

Porter County Valparaiso, IN

This short-term project will lead to long-term benefits for you:

- Enhanced safety features
- Reliability of service for years to come
- Less future maintenance work in your neighborhood

WHAT WE'RE DOING:

Upgrading approximately 38,000 feet of underground electrical lines. Transformers will be upgraded as necessary.

WHEN WE WILL BE WORKING: Work is expected to begin October 2019 and end March 2020. Restoration is expected to begin once the project is complete in April/May 2020.

All schedules are weather dependent.

Work will occur Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. - 5 p.m. On occasion, we may need to work evenings and weekends to honor customer appointments and deadlines.

OUR TEAM IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD:

You will see us working with our contractor, Meade. All of our employees and contractors can be identified by marked vehicles and also carry photo ID.

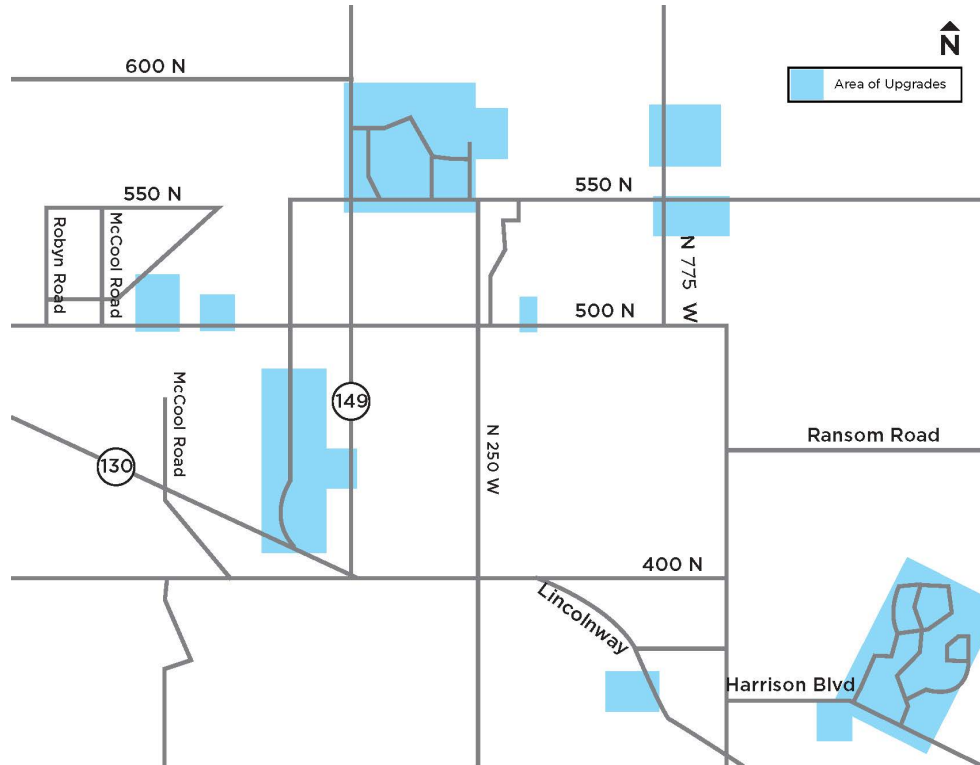
What to expect*:

- 1. Prep work.** To make sure no other underground utilities are damaged by this work, we will call 811 to have the public utilities marked with flags, stakes and temporary paint. *Please DO NOT remove these markings.*
- 2. Assess project path.** Obstructions in utility easements, such as fences and landscapes, may need to be removed.
- 3. Access to your property.** If we need access to your yard and/or if there are any issues within the path of construction, we will reach out to you directly.
- 4. Minimal service interruptions are expected to occur.** We will notify you ahead of time if a planned outage is needed.
- 5. Clean up.** After the project is complete, we will put back fences, lay black dirt and reseed. Please remember to water the new seed so it grows.

*If the project is complete during the winter months clean up may not happen until next spring.
